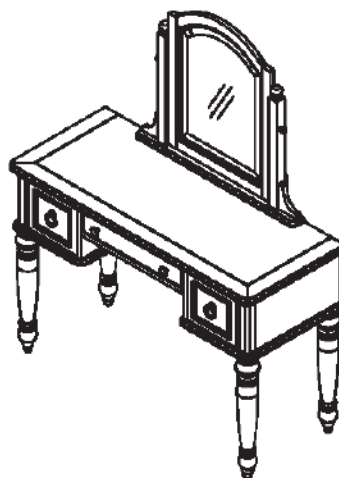


# Vanity with Mirror



## IMPORTANT

Carefully remove all the parts from the carton and place them individually on a soft cloth to prevent scratches or other damage.

Carefully and strictly follow these assembly instructions to ensure a completed product as designed.

Do not use power tools above 8 volts to assemble.

## Assembly Instructions 2/11

### IMPORTANT

- Use a soft cloth between these parts and the floor.
- Do not use power tools above 8 volts to assemble.
- Do not tighten all the screws until each part is properly assembled.
- The unit must be level to work properly. Use the included adjustable levelers to level.
- Keep Hex Wrench as the Bolts may need to be tightened in the future.

### STEP 1

Insert Cam Lock Screws into pre-drilled holes in Top (F), Side Panels (G), (H), Dividers (I), (J) and Back Panel (N), then tighten.

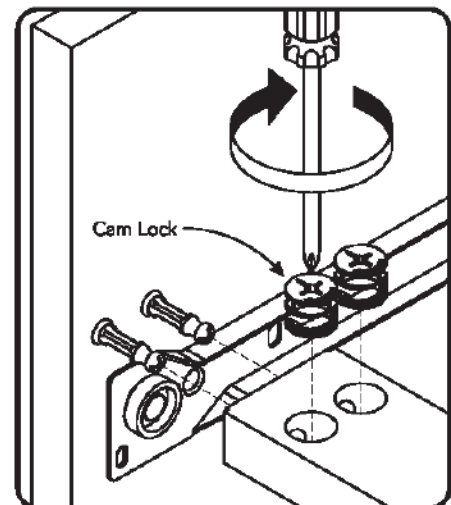
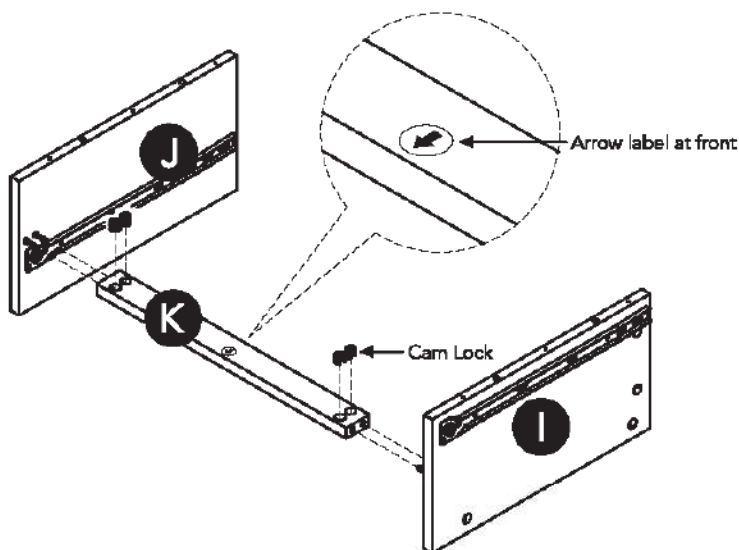
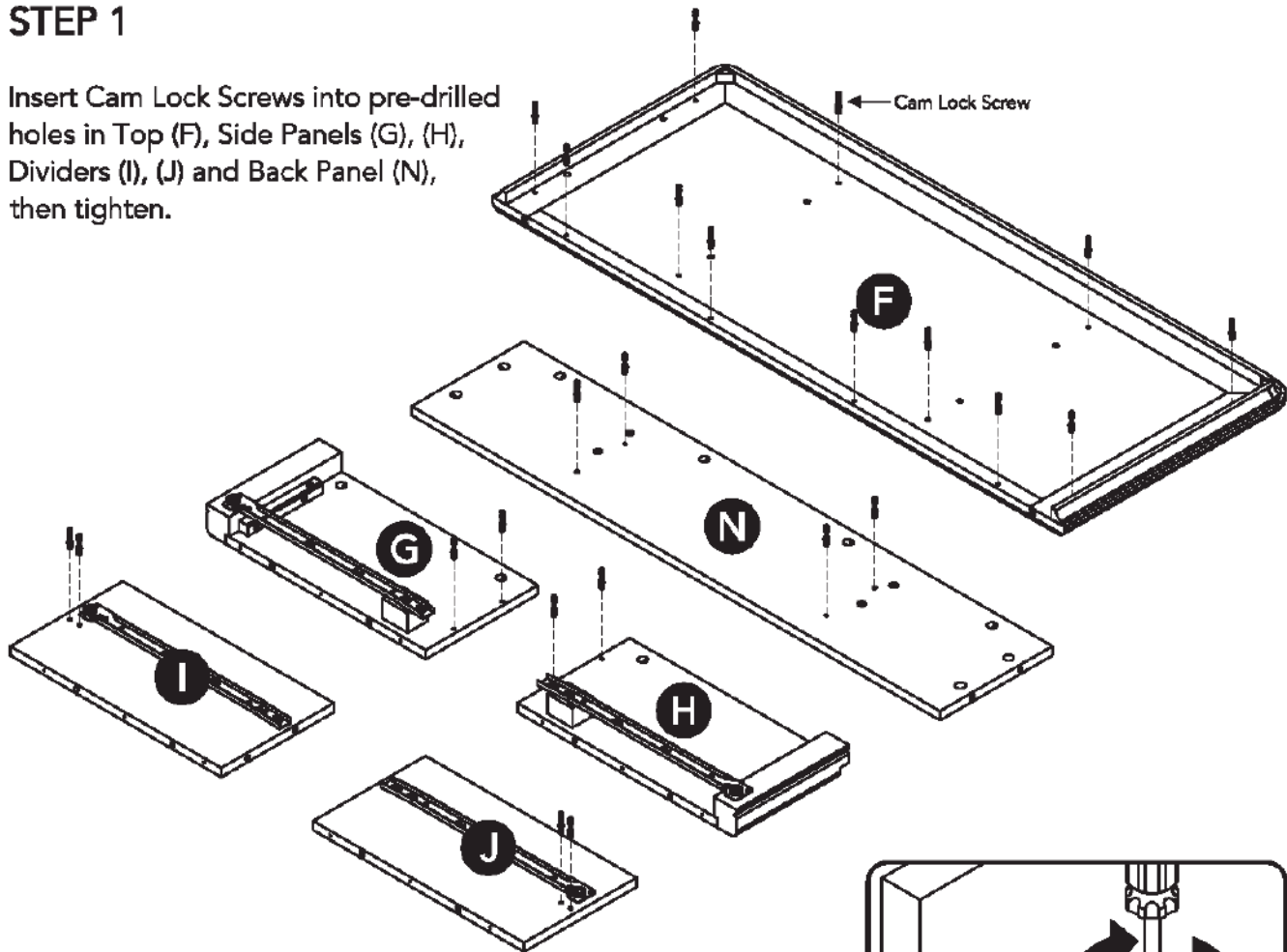

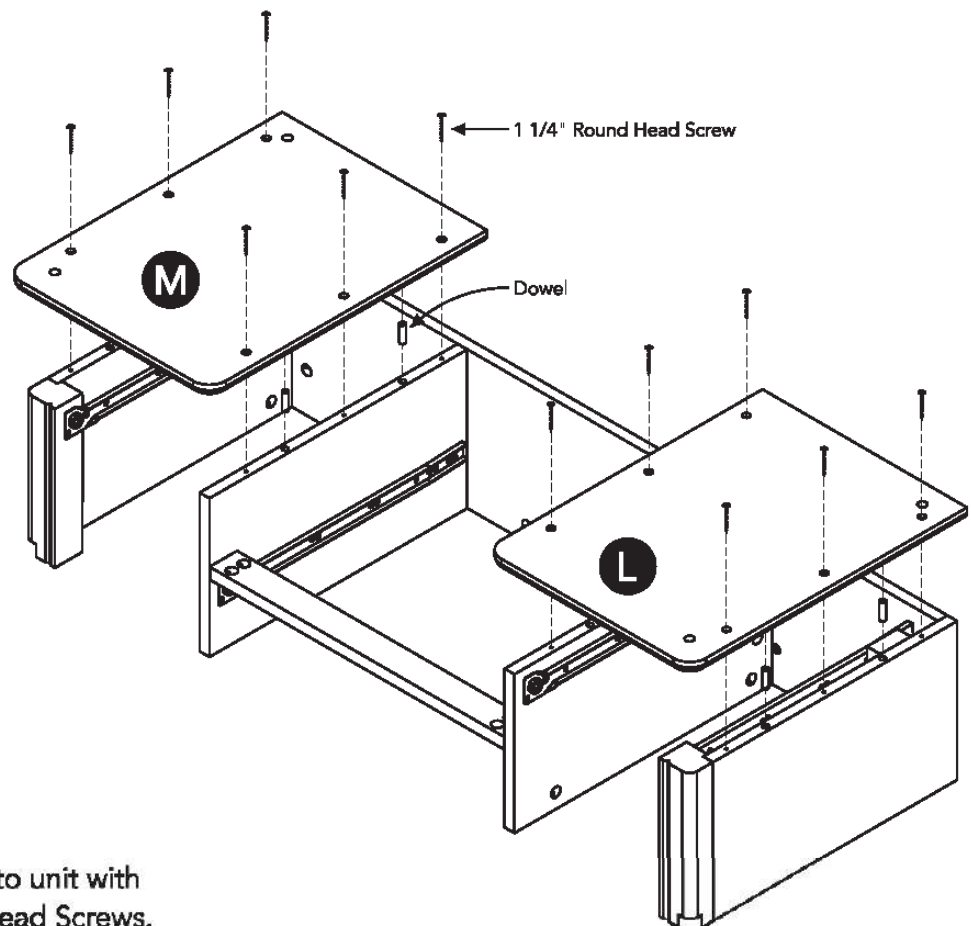
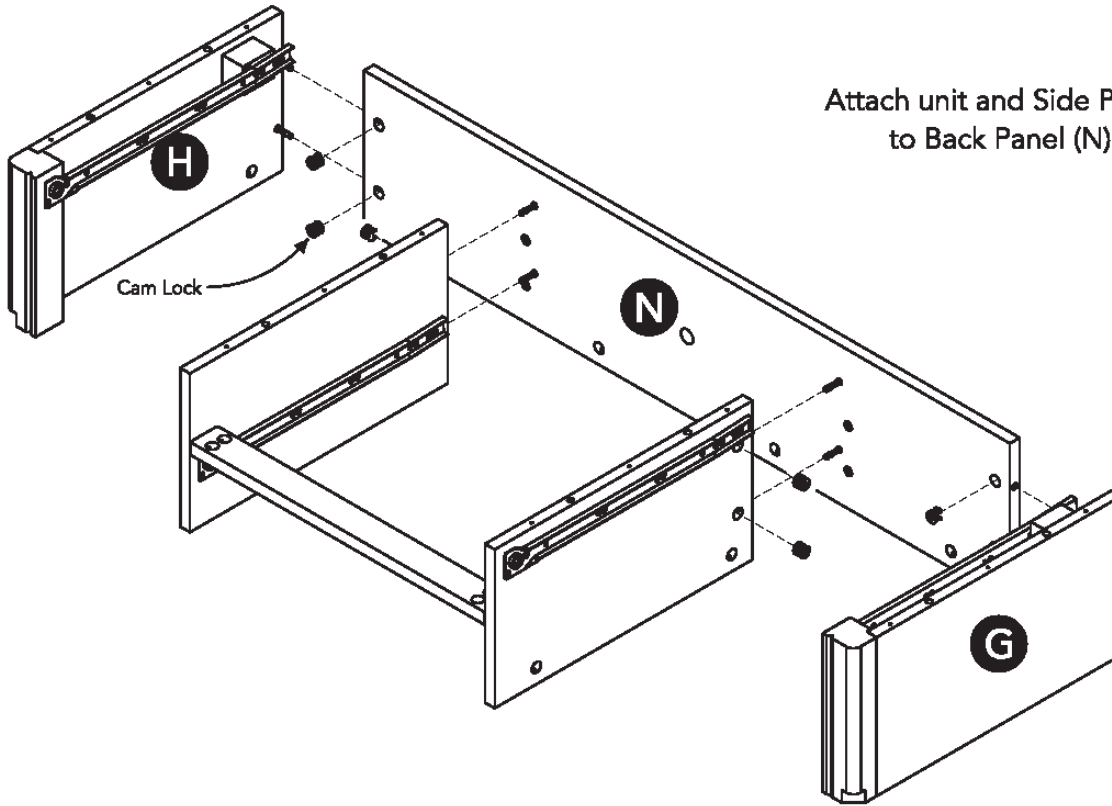
### STEP 2

Orientate Front Rail (K) with Arrow label at front, then attach Dividers (I) and (J) to Front Rail (K) with Cam Locks. (See Figure 1)

# Assembly Instructions 3/11

## STEP 3

Attach unit and Side Panels (G) and (H) to Back Panel (N) with Cam Locks.  
(See Figure 1)

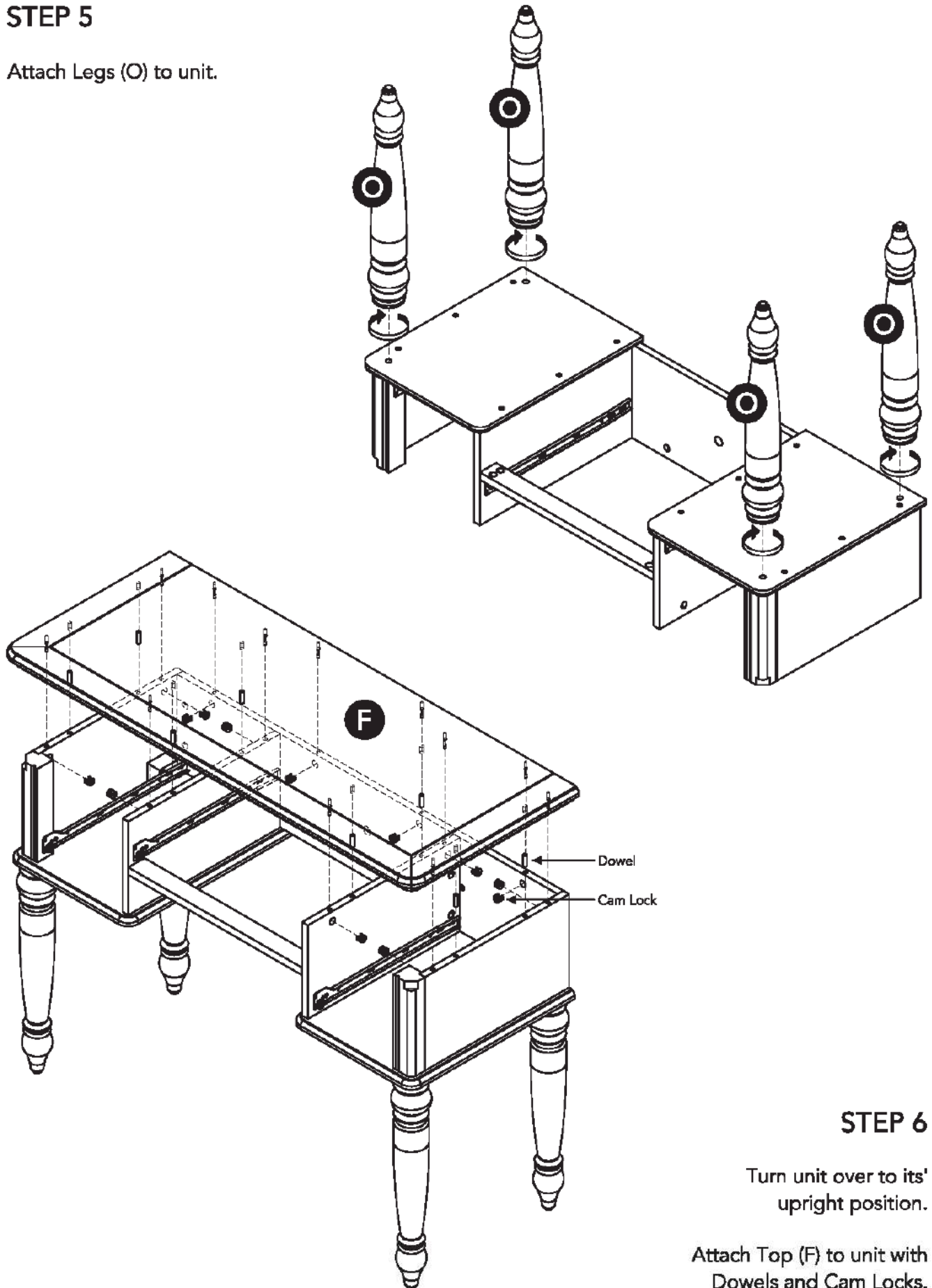


## STEP 4

Attach Bottoms (L) and (M) to unit with Dowels and 1 1/4" Round head Screws.

**STEP 5**

Attach Legs (O) to unit.



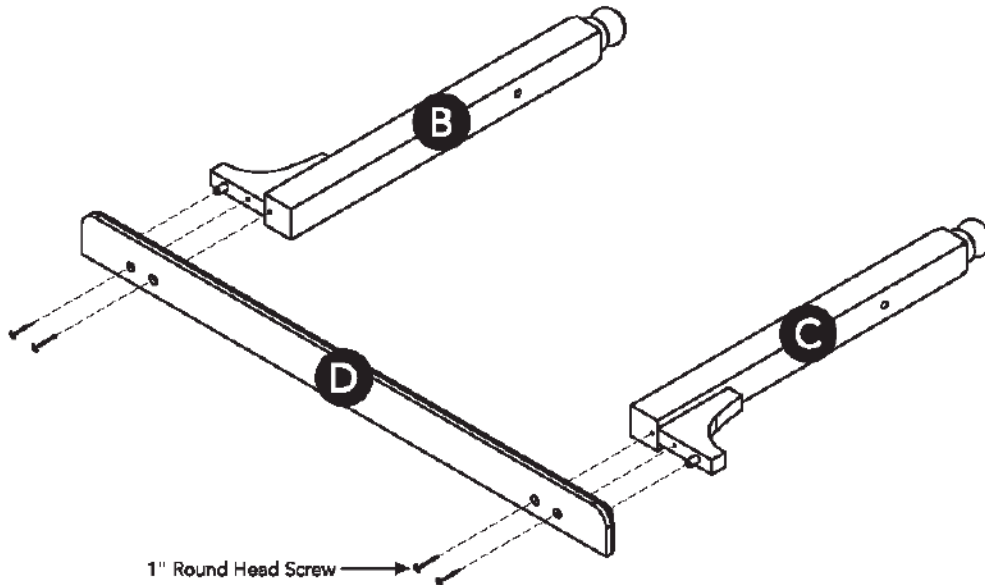
**STEP 6**

Turn unit over to its' upright position.

Attach Top (F) to unit with Dowels and Cam Locks.

## STEP 7

Attach Mirror Base (D) to Mirror Supports (B) and (C) with 1" Round Head Screws.



## STEP 8

Attach Mirror (A) to unit with Axis Bolts, Mirror Axes and Plastic Washers.  
(See Figure 2)

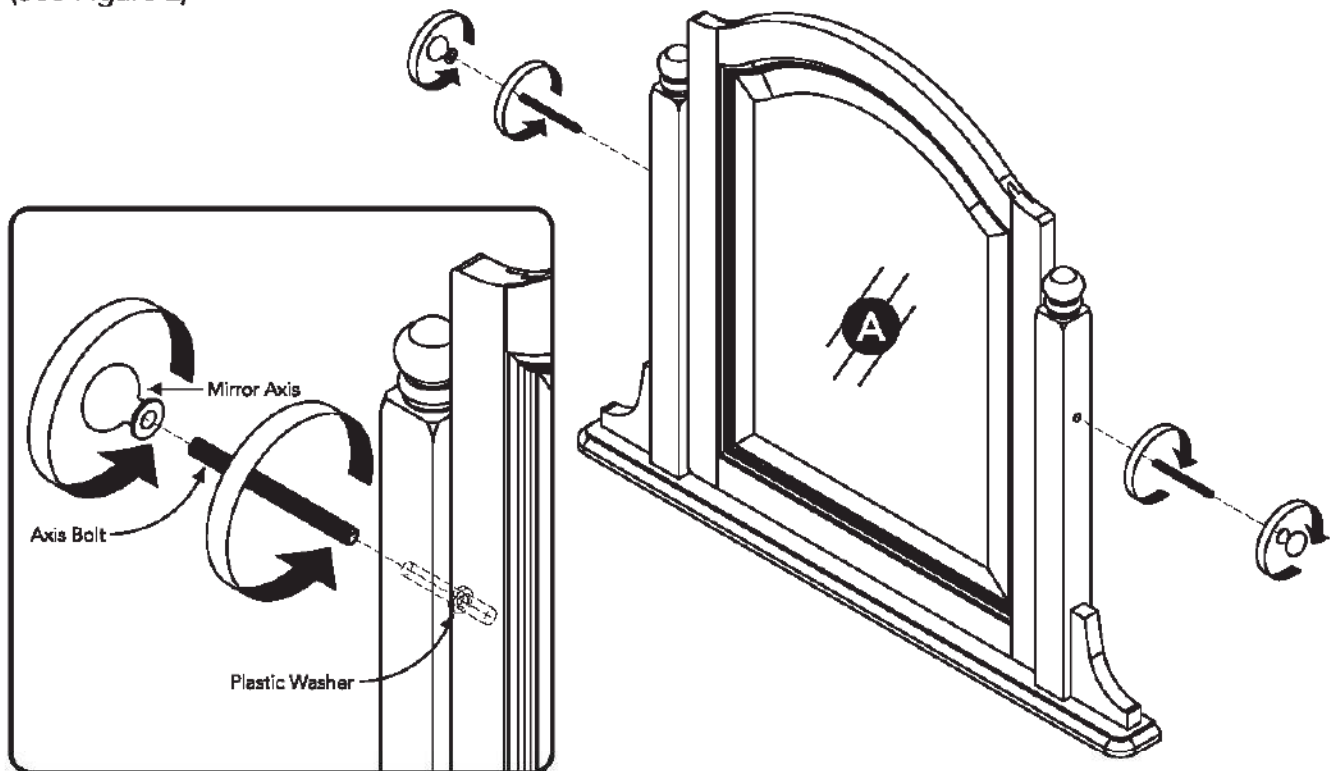

## Assembly Instructions 6/11

### STEP 9

Attach Battens (E) to unit from Step 6 and unit from Step 8 with Bolts, Spring Washers and Flat Washers.

Tighten Bolts with Hex Wrench. (See Figure 3)

Level unit by adjusting the adjustable levelers on bottom of unit. (See Figure 4)

Note : unit must be level to work properly.

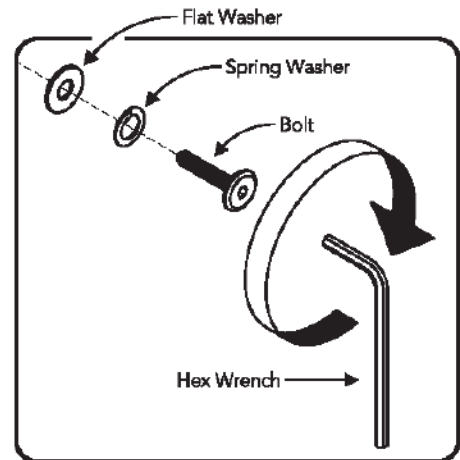
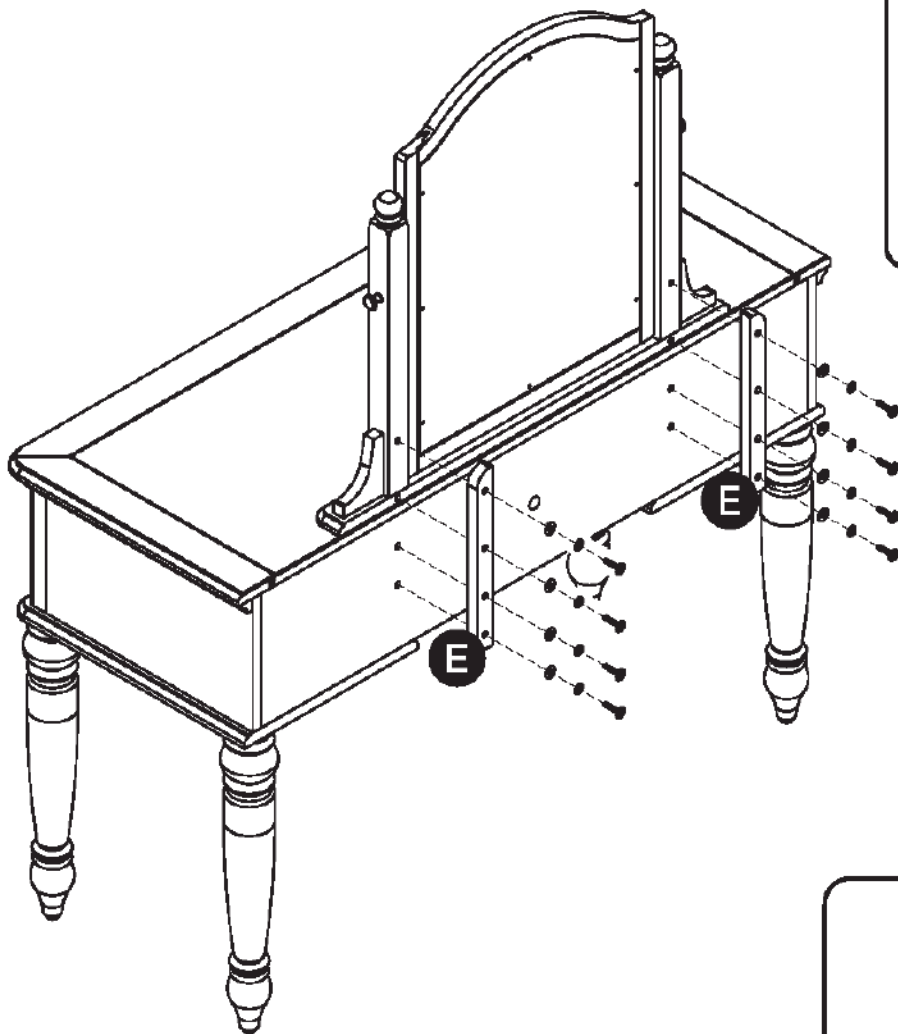

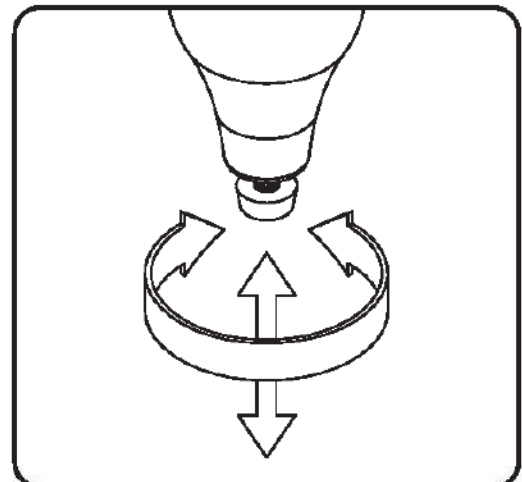

# Assembly Instructions 7/11

## IMPORTANT

• To help reduce the risk of the unit tipping over, the Tip-over Restraint must be installed following these instructions exactly.

## STEP 10

Place unit at desired location.

Mark wall with pencil to show position of hole in Back Panel (N). (See Figure 5)

Move unit.

Drill a 3/8" hole in wall 1" below mark.

Insert Anchor into the wall hole and attach Tip-over Restraint to Anchor with 1 1/2" Round Head Screw and Flat Washer. (See Figure 6)

Move unit back into place and insert Tip-over Restraint into unit through hole in Back Panel (N). (See Figure 7)

Attach Tip-over Restraint to unit with 1/2" Round Head Screw and Flat Washer. (See Figure 8)

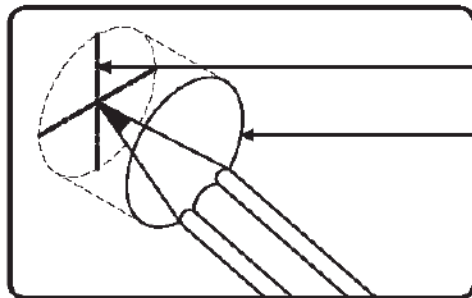
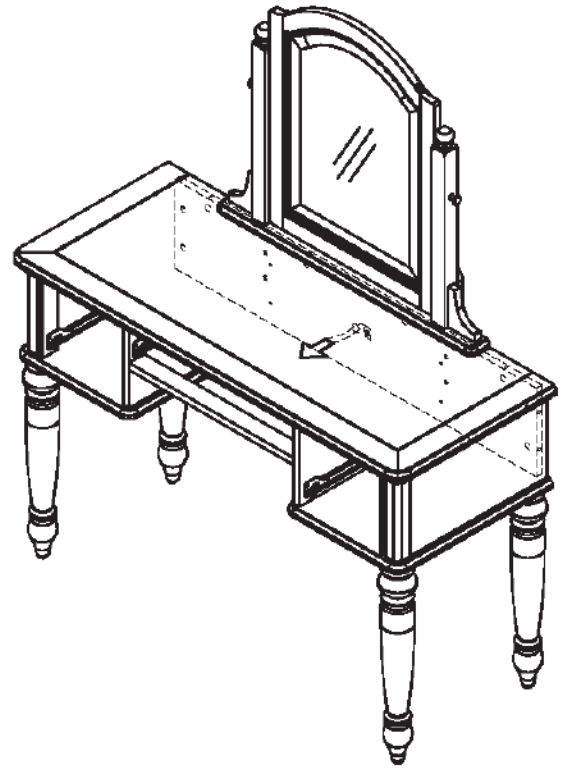

Hole in Back Panel (N)

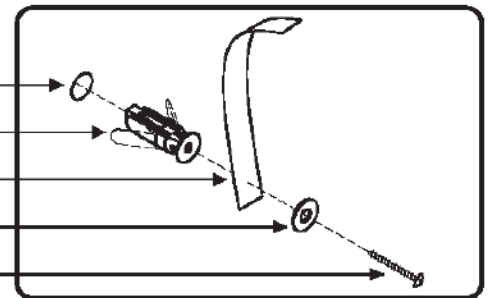

1 1/2" Round Head Screw

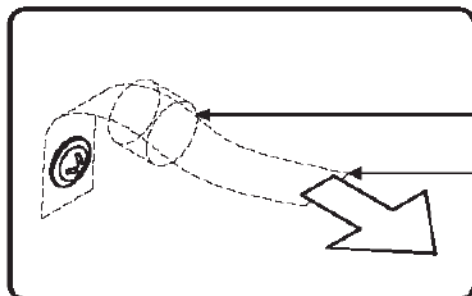

Tip-over Restraint

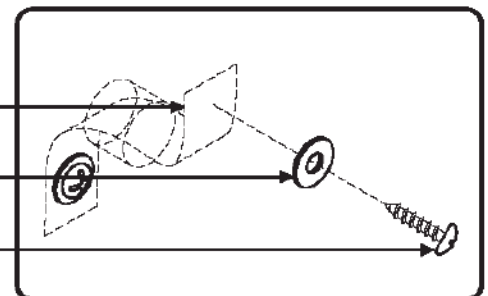

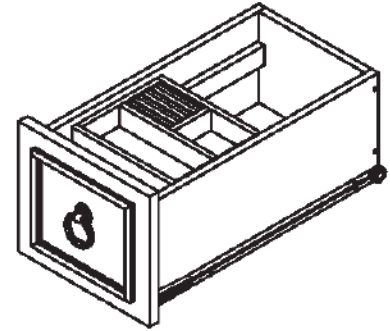

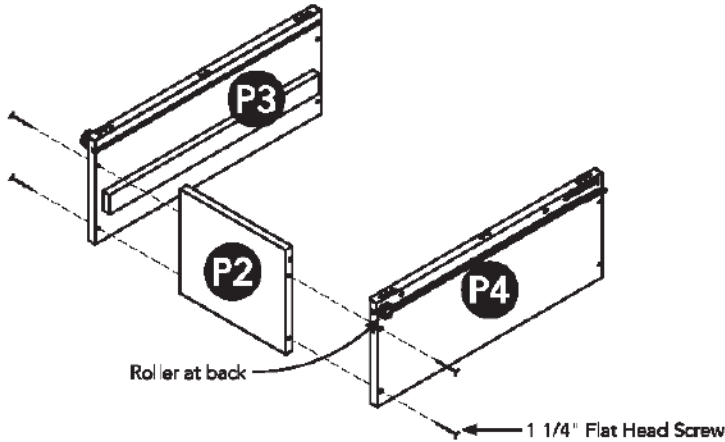

# Drawer (P)



## STEP 12

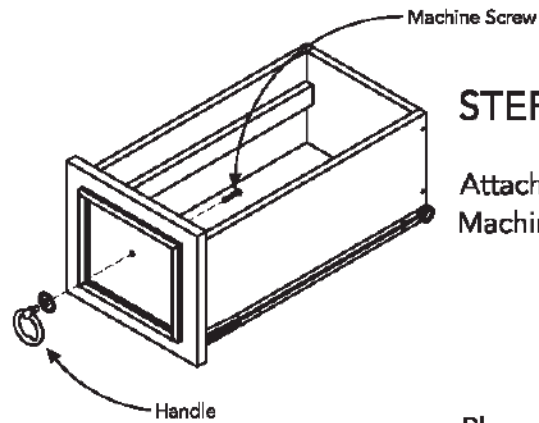
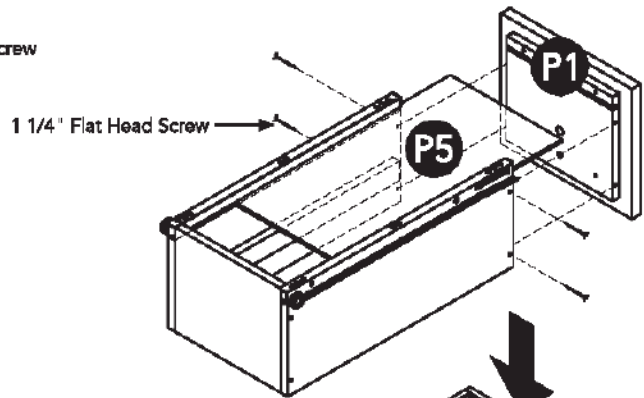
Attach Drawer Sides (P3) and (P4) to Drawer Back (P2) with 1 1/4" Flat Head Screws.



## STEP 13

Insert Drawer Bottom (P5) into groove.

Attach Drawer Front (P1) to unit with 1 1/4" Flat Head Screws.

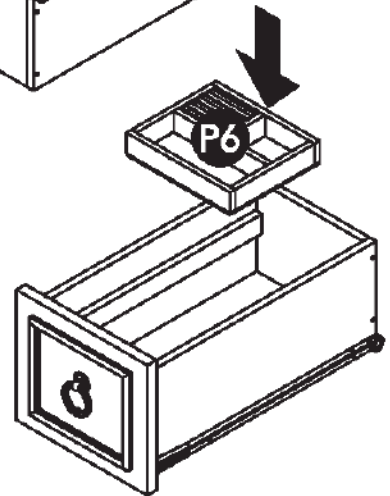


## STEP 14

Attach Handle with Machine Screw (short).

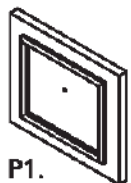
## STEP 15

Place Jewelry Box (P6) into position.



Note: Drawer assembly is not complete until 3/4" Flat Head Screws are used in a later step.

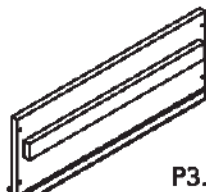

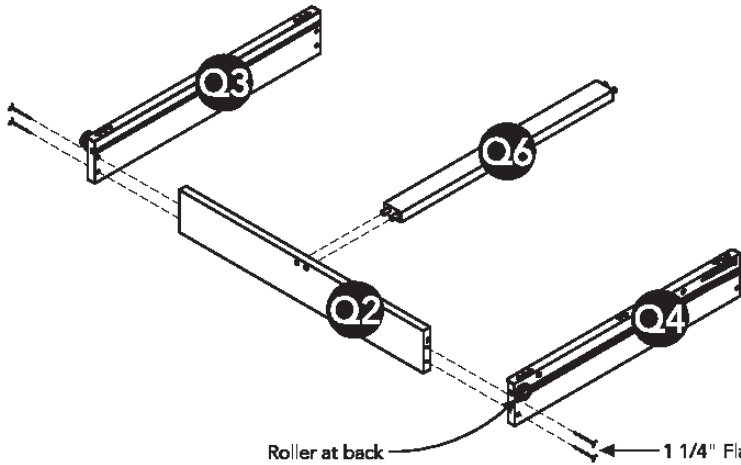


# Drawer (Q)



## STEP 16

Attach Drawer Sides (Q3), (Q4) and Drawer Support (Q6) to Drawer Back (Q2) with 1 1/4" Flat Head Screws.



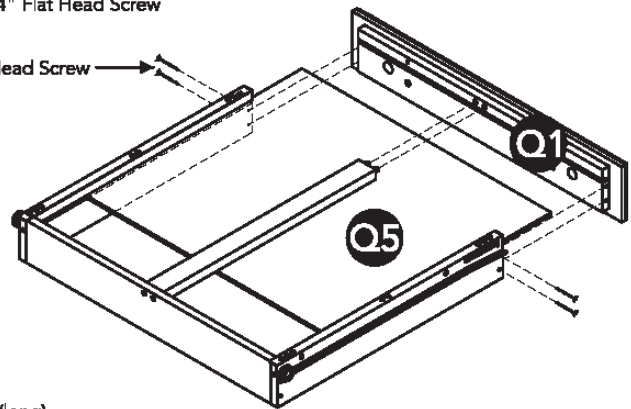

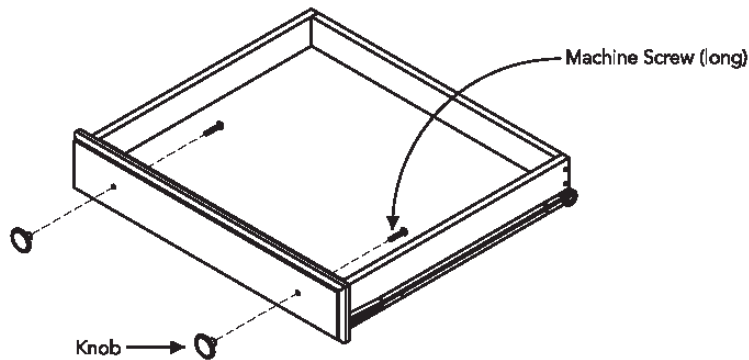
## STEP 17

Insert Drawer Bottom (Q5) into groove.

Attach Drawer Front (Q1) to unit with 1 1/4" Flat Head Screws.

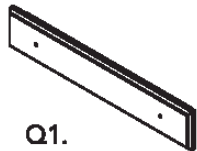

## STEP 18

Attach Knobs with Machine Screws (long).

Note: Drawer assembly is not complete until 3/4" Flat Head Screws are used in a later step.

## STEP 19

For Drawers (P) loosen slightly upper center screw and uninstall lower center screw.

For Drawer (Q) loosen slightly screws pre-installed on back of drawer front.



## STEP 20

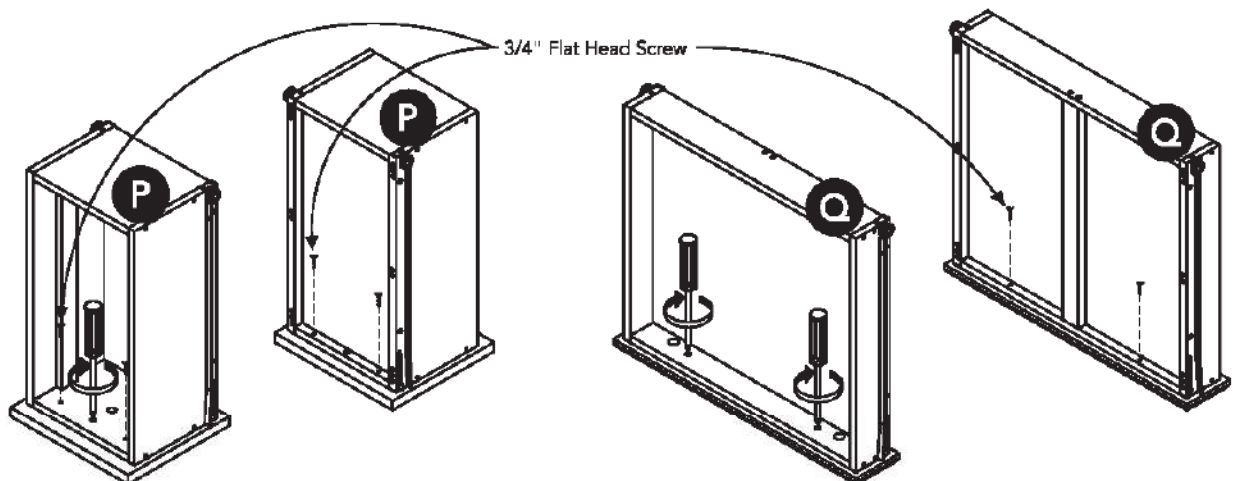
Insert drawers into unit, then adjust drawer front panels left or right and up or down until drawer gaps look proportional.

## STEP 21

Pull each drawer open slowly and re-tighten screws from Step 18.

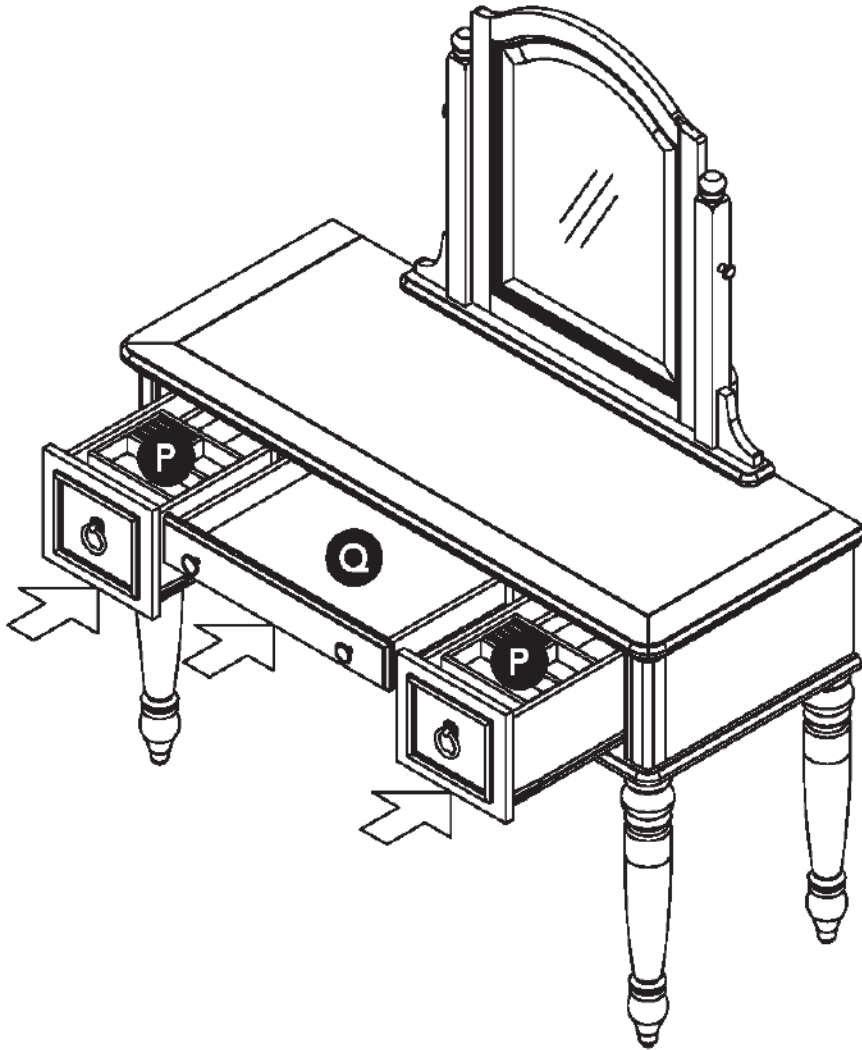
Make sure drawer front panels do not move and lock drawer front panels into position with 3/4" Flat Head Screws.

Note: These 3/4" Flat Head Screws must be installed to complete the drawer assembly.



STEP 22

Slide Drawers (P) and (Q) into position.



# CARE INSTRUCTIONS
