Series #109 48" x 18" Pot Rack Assembly Instructions

We have included these instructions to make assembling and mounting your Pot Rack as simple as possible. Familiarizing yourself with the parts and reading through these instructions carefully before assembly will help make putting together your Pot Rack easy and fast.

The only tools needed for assembly are a large screwdriver and an adjustable wrench. Other tools may be needed to properly install your Pot Rack. All parts were inspected before shipping. Assembly & Installation Instructions

1. Attach the 4 support arms to the upper crossmember using the 2 longest screws and nuts, leaving the bolts slightly loose.
2. Attach the 4 support arms to the 4 sections (2 curved end sections and 2 flat sections) that form the pot rack frame, fitting the support arms outside the pot rack frame. Use long screws in each of the bottom holes and short screws in each of the upper holes, leaving all screws slightly loose.
3. Square up the assembly by aligning the arms so that they are at right angles to the oval rack and the upper crossmember. Tighten all the screws.
4. Place the three grids sections inside the pot rack frame so that the grids are resting upon the long lower screws protruding from the pot rack frame. Make sure the grid stops are facing down. (see detail, figure 2)
5. Attach the double eye hook extensions to the upper crossmember.

Mounting the rack to the ceiling

This rack must be mounted directly into the solid wood of ceiling joists or beams. It is unsafe to mount this rack in any other manner. If you are unsure how to mount this rack safely please consult a qualified carpenter or handyperson.

1. Drill 2 holes, 16" on center.
2. Screw ceiling hooks into the holes. Align the ceiling hooks so they are both facing in the same direction, at right angles to the direction in which you wish to mount the rack.
3. Hang the rack by inserting the double eye hook extensions into the ceiling hooks. Because this rack is large and heavy you may need a helper to lift and position the rack.
4. Lift the center grid and insert the 2 pot hooks/grid supports so they are supporting the middle of the center grid. (See figure 1)
5. Place the other pot hooks as desired on the pot rack frame &/or hanging from the grids.

Care and Use

Always distribute the weight of any items stored on the grid or hung on the pot rack evenly. Hang pot hooks only from the interior squares of the grid. Do not hang hooks from the perimeter or cut portions of the grid.

Decor Copper Finish: The copper plating has been given a clear, protective coating to prevent tarnishing. Clean with a soft, damp cloth. You can also use a window cleaner. Dry thoroughly. Never use abrasive cleaners.

Satin Nickel Finish: The nickel plating has been given a clear, protective coating to prevent tarnishing. Clean with a soft, damp cloth. You can also use a window cleaner. Dry thoroughly. Never use abrasive cleaners.

Chrome Finish: Clean with a soft, damp cloth. You may also use a window cleaner. Dry thoroughly. Never use abrasive cleaners.

Powder Coat Finish: Clean with a sponge, moistened with dishwashing solution. Dry thoroughly. Never use abrasive cleaners.

Warning: It is important that your rack is properly assembled and mounted. If the rack is incorrectly assembled, mounted or used it could become unstable or collapse, possibly causing damage or injury.
